An American conquers France

The Tour de France is the greatest cycle race in the world – 3,500 kilometres, nearly one month of pedalling up and down hill in the French summer heat. And since 1999 this race has been dominated by the American Lance Armstrong. He is the world's best cyclist – and the biggest earner in this sport. Last year he made about \$ 15 million.

The secret of his success is hard work and amazing fitness. His heart is much larger than an ordinary person's. His pulse rate at rest is about 32 beats a minute, half the average rate. When he is cycling hard, his heart can speed up to over 200 beats a minute.

This cycling superman was born on September 18, 1971 in Plano, Texas. He was brought up by his mother. Lance was an excellent swimmer and started entering triathlons as a teenager. He also took part in cycle races.



In 1993, aged 22, he had his first success in the Tour de France. That year he also won the World Road Cycling Championships.

Three years later it looked as if Armstrong's brilliant career was over. He was diagnosed with cancer. He had an operation and needed intensive chemotherapy. The chemicals used were so powerful they destroyed his muscles and permanently damaged his kidneys. It took him some time to recover from his illness. After his recovery Armstrong felt he had been given a second chance. He began training just five months after his diagnosis and his cycling actually improved. He spends up to 35 hours per week on his bike.

Asked after his latest Tour de France win if he wanted to go on to win again, Armstrong replied that that was not the way he wanted to be remembered. "There's never been a Tour de France victory by a cancer survivor before me. That's what I'd like to be remembered for."
